6th -12th Grade

- Abortion ends the life of the baby. This can be performed the entire 9 months of the pregnancy in certain states. However, the laws are changing rapidly to protect the lives of the babies in their mother's wombs. It is important that we continue to pray for the end to abortion.

Roe v. Wade

- The Roe v. Wade decision was made on January 22, 1973. This decision made abortion legal. The Catholic bishops of the United States have designated January 22 as a special day of prayer and penance in reparation for the abortions that have resulted from the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court Decision.
- on June 24, 2022, thanks to the prayers and works of many people, *Roe v. Wade* was Overturned! This day has been long-awaited for almost 50 years! This decision returned the legal decision of abortion to the people and their state legislators. Abortion is still legal in many places. It is important that we continue to pray for protection of unborn children and their parents.

Discussion of The Elderly

How do the elderly (grandparents) help us? Why are they valuable?

-What can we do to reach out to the elderly?

6th - 8th Grade Additional Discussion

Discuss euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide and why these are not part of God's plan. Euthanasia is a method of killing someone without their consent and is a passive act. Physician-assisted suicide technically includes the consent of the one who will be put to death. Many people who are in favor of euthanasia or physician-assisted suicide use deceptive vocabulary. They may call it "assisted killing" or "dying with dignity."

God calls each one of us to not only pray for our family and friends, but also for those we do not know. Some of them have made some really poor choices, but we are not to judge others. Because of God's Resurrection, the sins of all, including those who are incarcerated, can be forgiven. If God forgives, will you? Only God knows what is in their hearts and only He can judge them.
